**Vision:** Women and girls have the resources and opportunities to reach their full potential and live their dreams.

**Mission:** Soroptimist is a global organization that provides women and girls with access to the education and training they need to achieve economic empowerment.

Soroptimist Global Impact in FY 21/22:

- 2.7 Million + in educations awards distribution
- 1,891 inspiring women received an award
- 959 women received additional support beyond an award

Women are Economically Empowered:

- 81% completed their education and improved their standard of living
- 93% increased in their self-esteem
- 96% are now living in a safe environment of the 56% who are survivors of gendered violence
