During the presentation, the audience will learn about the Suspect Child Abuse Report (SCAR), Mandated reporting, Emergency Response (ER), Resource Family Approval (RFA), Family Reunification (FR), Family Maintenance (FM), Adoptions (AD), Permanency Planning (PP), AB12 (Extended Foster Care) and Independent Living Program (ILP), and community involvement.

**Trish Shubert** obtained her Bachelor's in Human Services and Master's in Business Administration from the University of Phoenix. Her first five (5) years, Tarae gained experience in the Emergency Response, Family Reunification/Family Maintenance programs, and developed the AB12/Independent Living Program (ILP) program for Kings. In February 2017, Tarae was promoted to Supervisor over the Adoption and AB12/ILP unit. In August 2020, Tarae was promoted to Program Manager, which is her current position. Tarae oversees the following programs: Family Reunification/Family Maintenance, Adoptions and Social Service Assistance (SSA).

Jean Reyes began his time with Kings County HSA in 2017 as an intern in Emergency Response. Jean then continued in ER as a Practitioner and later in Adoptions. Jean served as Supervisor in Family Reunification/Family Maintenance. Presently, Jean is the Program Manager for our Permanency Planning, AB-12/ILP, Clerical, and Staff Development programs. Jean has a B.S. degree in Psychology from Cal Poly San Luis Obispo and a MSW degree from Fresno State where he graduated from the Title IV-E program. Jean's practice has always been focused on being family-centered, strength-based, and solution-focused. Jean is passionate about instilling hope in the work we do while working diligently to turn that hope into positive outcomes for the children and families in our community.
