### **Presentations**

- CA PREP Updates by Evi Hernandez
  - KPFP serves as Coalition for CA PREP
  - o Jason Spitzer spoke to the group on behalf of CA PREP
    - 21 agencies funded by CA PREP
    - Evidenced based curriculum
    - "Be proud, be responsible"
    - Educating youth in communities on STI's and teen pregnancy to help reduce rates
    - Targeting communities who are in high need of sexual health education like those above state average for birth rates, foster care, and homeless
    - CASHNI- is a score which counties are eligible based on adolescent birth rates, repeat teen births, gonorrhea rate, percent of youth living in poverty, youth in isolates areas, and rural community status
- Youth Prevention Summit by Van VanLandingham
  - o (handout)
  - o Prevention youth summit- focuses on all forms of prevention
  - The Trevor Project teaches on crisis intervention and suicide prevention in LBGQT community
    - Between 15-24 ages, suicide is 3<sup>rd</sup> leading cause of death
  - Partners with multiple agencies in Tulare County: NAMI and Choices-Breaking the Silence, the Trevor project, Tulare County Tobacco Awareness and Education, District Attorney's, Child Welfare Services, Family Services, Tulare County Health and Human Service Agency, Crossroads TAY Housing Program
    - Teen dating violence, cyber bulling, nutrition & obesity, homelessness, alcohol & tobacco awareness, rape prevention, human trafficking and adding gang prevention
  - Showing a model for KPFP and how to reach out to our community to start Prevention Youth Summit in Kings County
- Childhood Obesity Conference by Becky Durrenberger
  - Promoting health rather than size
  - Obese children 1.6x more likely to be bullied
  - o 70% of our body weight is genetic- highly heritable
  - Toxic Noise: rules about why, what, and when to eat interfere with positive body care today
  - Parents and peers endorse a preference for thinness, weight control, body dissatisfaction, dieting which could lead to youth feeling bad about their weight and lose weight in harmful ways
  - "You cannot solve problems with the same thinking that created them"
  - Promote health enhancing behaviors the same for everyone, regardless of size
  - "Don't set goals a dead person could achieve better"

- Examine own biases, teach the holistic model, recommend what to do vs. what not to do, prepare to be repetitive, model what we teach, be ecological-find platforms for a whole-community approach
