- Non-Profit, direct services for women
- Safe house for adult females
- 5 beds; 8 collaborative homes state wide; 12 alcohol & drug facilities
- No cut off date to stay in the home; 30 day assessments
- Provides non- residential & case management services
- 96% of sex trackers start around 11 years old
- Fresno one of the five largest areas for human trafficking
- Works alongside with law enforcement
- Trafficking in persons report (TIP)
- High poverty, immigration population are some major risk factors
